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STIPULATION


The parties hereto, by and through the undersigned counsel, hereby stipulate as follows:

1. Except as provided in paragraph 2 below, the date for any defendant to answer, demur or otherwise respond to the First Amended Complaints filed by the Independent Plaintiffs in the above-referenced actions shall be continued to and including April 2, 2007. Plaintiffs' opposition to any demurrer or other motion shall be filed and served by May 7, 2007. Defendants' reply papers shall be filed and served by May 21, 2007. To the extent possible, defendants will submit joint demurrers/motions. The hearing date on any demurrers/motions shall be set on a date convenient to the Court that is after May 28, 2007.

2. If a defendant has a writ petition pending with respect to a previously-asserted jurisdictional challenge, the response date shall be ten days after service on that defendant of notice that the writ proceedings are concluded as to that defendant, in accordance with Code of Civil Procedure § 418.10(e).

3. Any defendant may, at its election, respond by filing a short pleading stating that it is standing on its previously-filed answer and affirmative defenses, in which case any new matters alleged in the First Amended Complaints shall be deemed denied.




