21 The parties, by and through their respective attorneys of record, hereby stipulate:

22 1. A Global Settlement Agreement has been negotiated among all MSA Settling  
23 States, including California, defendant House of Prince A/S, Carolina Tobacco Company, and  
24 Leonidias Trading Company.

25 2. If the Global Settlement Agreement is "finalized," as set forth in the agreement, it  
26 will result in payment of over \$50 million to the Settling States from House of Prince, Carolina  
27 Tobacco Company and Leonidias Trading Company.

1           3. If finalized, the agreement will resolve all the People's claims in this action  
2 against House of Prince, and upon finalization the People will dismiss this action.

3           4. Pursuant to the Global Settlement Agreement, the Settling States shall take all  
4 steps necessary or appropriate to obtain waivers of the "most favored nations" provisions of the  
5 MSA (section XVIII(b)) "from all persons or entities that the Settling States deem reasonably  
6 necessary." (Global Settlement Agreement, ¶ 7.)

7           5. The Global Settlement Agreement also provides that under certain conditions  
8 either the Settling States or House of Prince may terminate the agreement if, within 120 days  
9 after the last party has executed the agreement, the waivers have not been obtained by the  
10 Settling States. (*Id.*, ¶ 8.)

11           6. Although the Settling States and House of Prince executed the Global Settlement  
12 Agreement in 2005, Carolina Tobacco, a non-participating manufacturer, did not execute the  
13 agreement until its discharge from bankruptcy in early 2006, and Leonidias Trading did not  
14 execute the agreement until May 12, 2006.

15           7. Consequently, the parties jointly request that the court continue the June 2, 2006,  
16 status conference for 120 days, until Friday October 6, 2006. If the Global Settlement


