- 4. Enter your name. First Name, Last Name and Party Description (optional). For example, Amy Smith-Petitioner.

- 6. Once connected successfully, you will see a screen that will indicate 'Hey [your name], someone in the meeting should let you in soon'.
- 7. Click Device Settings.
- 8. Make a Test Call.
- 9. Hang up from the Teams meeting.


