GENERAL ORDER OF THE PRESIDING DEPARTMENT

ORDER NO. 032420-36

Due to the ongoing health and safety issues caused by the COVID-19 pandemic and the emergency declarations and orders of government officials related thereto as outlined in the General Order of the Presiding Department, IN RE: Administrative Order of the Presiding Judge Re: COVID-19 Pandemic, Order No. 031820-34, and in order to meet the need of providing essential court functions to the community, the court issues this addendum to General Order No. 031820-34 and adds the following items to the list of time-sensitive, essential functions enumerated in paragraph 4 therein that will go forward during the court closure from March 17, 2020 through April 3, 2020:

- Emergency surrogacy order requests (members of the public with such a need are asked to notify the court with their request through the email address: FAM@SDCOURT.CA.GOV).
- Chamber ex parte requests for Elder Abuse, Workplace Violence and School Violence Restraining Orders.
- Probable cause determinations for persons arrested without a warrant.
- Requests and orders for lower bail or own recognizance release from custody pursuant to Penal Code § 1269c.
- Requests and orders for release from custody pursuant to stipulations between defense counsel and the prosecution.

This addendum solely adds the above to the list of time-sensitive, essential functions that will go forward during the emergency closure of the court and makes no other changes to General Order No. 031820-34.

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
