- Emergency surrogacy order requests (members of the public with such a need are asked to notify the court with their request through the email address: FAM@SDCOURT.CA.GOV).
- Chamber ex parte requests for Elder Abuse, Workplace Violence and School Violence Restraining Orders.
- Probable cause determinations for persons arrested without a warrant.

2 3	• Requests and orders for release from custody pursuant to stipulations between defense counsel and the prosecution.
4	This addendum solely adds the above to the list of time-sensitive, essential functions that
5	will go forward during the emergency closure of the court and makes no other changes to General
6	Order No. 031820-34.
