Due to the ongoing health and safety issues caused by the COVID-19 pandemic and the emergency declarations and orders of government officials related thereto as outlined in the General Order of the Presiding Department, *IN RE: Second Implementation Order of the Presiding Judge Re: COVID-19 Pandemic*, Order No. 040320-39, and in order to meet the need of providing essential court functions to the community, the court issues this addendum to General Order No. 040320-39 and adds the following items to the list of time-sensitive, essential functions enumerated in paragraph 4 therein that will go forward during the court closure from April 6, 2020 through April 30, 2020:

- Lanterman-Petris-Short (LPS) Act (Welf. & Inst. Code, § 5332) Petitions Regarding
 Capacity to Consent to or Refuse Antipsychotic Medication (*Riese* Hearings) and, for
 these patients, Welfare & Institutions Code section 5254 Certification Review Hearings,
 remotely via telephone conference.
- Additional Certification Review Hearings will be progressively calendared during the closure in cooperation with the Office of the Public Defender and the Office of Patient Advocacy.

• The court will hear writs and appeals arising from the above-described hearings.

This addendum solely adds the above to the list of time-sensitive and/or essential functions that will go forward during the emergency closure of the court and makes no other changes to General Order No. 040320-39.
