Due to the ongoing health and safety issues caused by the COVID-19 pandemic and the emergency declarations and orders of government officials related thereto as outlined in the General Order of the Presiding Department, *IN RE: Second Implementation Order of the Presiding Judge Re: COVID-19 Pandemic*, Order No. 040320-39, and in order to meet the need of providing essential court functions to the community, the court issues this addendum to General Order No. 040320-39 and adds the following items to the list of time-sensitive, essential functions enumerated in paragraph 4 therein that will go forward during the current court closure:

- Juvenile Restraining Orders and Disposition Hearings.
- Emergency requests pursuant to Welfare & Institutions Code § 827.
- Motions for New Trial pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure §§ 656 et seq.
- Motions for Judgment Notwithstanding the Verdict pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure § 629.
- Pursuant to Emergency Rules of Court, rule 6(c)(5), ex parte Juvenile Dependency requests asking the court to adopt the recommendations of the child welfare agency (including but not limited to family maintenance reviews, post permanency

planning reviews, and 6-month, 12-month and 18-month reviews) where all counsel have submitted written stipulations.

• Effective April 20, 2020, Petitions for Writ of Habeas Corpus and any motions and filings related thereto.

This addendum solely adds the above to the list of time-sensitive and/or essential functions that will go forward during the emergency closure of the court and makes no other changes to General Order No. 040320-39.

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AND MAY BE AMENDED AS CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRE.
