- Upon remittitur from the California Supreme Court or a California Court of Appeal,
 the issuance, filing and processing of documents, including orders and judgments,
 to effectuate orders issued by the appellate court.
- The issuance, filing and processing of documents, including orders and judgments, in order to comply with any orders or directives issued by an appellate court or the Chief Justice of the California Supreme Court.

This addendum solely adds the above to the list of time-sensitive and/or essential functions that will go forward during the emergency closure of the court and makes no other changes to General Order No. 040320-39.
