Based on the application presented to the court by the social worker in this matter, the court makes the following findings and orders:

- 1. There is probable cause to believe that the child is, or appears to come, within the description of Welf. & Inst. Code § 300.
- 2. Continuance in the home is contrary to the child's welfare.
- 3. There is probable cause to believe:

(a) Protective Custody Warrant Under WIC § 340(a)

The child should be placed into protective custody because:

- (1) The child's physical environment poses an imminent threat to the child's health or safety and there are no reasonable means by which the child can be protected without temporary removal from the physical custody of the parents or guardians.
