CHAPTER 4 DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RESTRAINING ORDERS (DVRO)

Rule 5.4.1

Domestic Violence Restraining Orders

Temporary and permanent domestic violence restraining orders are governed by the applicable statutes and California Rules of Court rules 5.380 through 5.386.

Rule 5.4.2

Residence Removal Orders

If the court orders the restrained party removed from the residence, the protected party must prepare and submit for the court's signature, a separate order on local Form SDSC D-072, Order for Removal from Residence. The Sheriff requires two certified copies of the removal order. (Adopted 1/1/2005; Renum. 1/1/2006; Rev. 1/1/2008; Rev. 1/1/2012; Rev. 1/1/2014)

Rule 5.4.3

Modifying and Terminating a Restraining Order

A. Modification or termination of a restraining order prior to its expiration date is governed by Family Code, section 6345.

B. Any party may request a modification of a restraining order prior to expiration by filing a noticed motion and must include a proposed order on Judicial Council Form DV-130 (Restraining Order After Hearing).

C. Requests to terminate a restraining order before its expiration date by the protected party may be made by filing local form SDSC D-001 (Ex Parte Request and Order to Terminate Restraining Order). If granted, the court will deliver a copy of the order to the Sheriff for removal from CLETS.

D. Requests to terminate a restraining order before its expiration date by a restrained person must be made by filing a noticed motion.
