Effective June 30, 2014, documents **may be filed electronically** in non-mandated civil cases in the North County Division where either: (1) the case is first initiated on or after June 30, 2014; or (2) the case is already pending as of June 30, 2014 and has been imaged by the court. The case types that shall be subject to mandatory eFiling are: civil class actions; consolidated and coordinated actions where all cases involved are imaged cases; and actions that are provisionally complex under CRC 3.400-3.403 as set forth in the Civil Cover Sheet, Judicial Council form CM-010. “Complex cases” included in mandatory eFiling include Antitrust/Trade Regulation, Mass Tort, Environmental/Toxic Tort, and Securities Litigation cases, as well as insurance coverage claims arising from these case types. The free training program offered by the Superior Court and One Legal has been approved for MCLE credit.
