San Diego Superior Court Seeks Short-Term Volunteers

Court Needs Assistance Transitioning To New Central Courthouse

The San Diego Superior Court is seeking short-term volunteers to help people access the New Central Courthouse when it opens in January 2017. After 55 years of using the Old Court facility at 220 West Broadway, jurors and the public will need help finding new courtrooms and business counters at the Union Street facility. The Court needs assistance in two areas:

Pedestrian Bridges Connecting Old and New Courthouses

Volunteers will not need computer skills for this task, as they will be giving the public directional advice on the pedestrian bridges connecting the new Courthouse with the Hall of Justice and the Old Central Courthouse. The Old Central Courthouse will continue to house trials for several weeks after the opening of the new Courthouse as a staggered move schedule will be used to transition more than 600 employees and judicial officers.

Hall of Justice and New Central Courthouse Information Desks

Volunteers will need computer skills to look up information on a Court computer to help people find correct courtrooms or business offices.

The volunteer commitment will include the following: Available one day of the work week (Monday-Friday). Minimum commitment of one (1) six (6) hour shift per week. Schedules will start in January with a commitment through mid-March. Training and parking will be provided. Volunteers must pass a background check via fingerprint (LiveScan) to be eligible.
