



1 for the purpose of modifying their sentences to permit early release of such persons with or  
2 without supervision or to community-based organizations for treatment.”


3 Based on the above, there is an immediate and continuing need to protect the health and  
4 safety of the jail population and staff, by reducing the jail population, in order to help prevent the  
5 spread of the coronavirus. To accomplish this goal, and in accord with the Chief Justice’s  
6 advisory of March 20, 2020, this court hereby authorizes the San Diego County Sheriff’s  
7 Department to accelerate the release of sentenced county jail inmates up to 60 days from when  
8 they would otherwise be released, except that no inmate may receive the benefit of early release  
9 pursuant to both this order and Penal Code § 4024.1.

10 In addition to any other notice required by law, the Sheriff’s Department shall, no later  
11 than 24 hours prior to the release of any inmate pursuant to this order, notify the San Diego  
12 District Attorney, the San Diego City Attorney, the San Diego Office of the Public Defender.  
13 The Sheriff shall insure that notification procedures made pursuant to VINE reflect the  
14 accelerated release dates.

15 THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, supersedes General Order 040120-38,  
16 and shall remain in effect until April 30, 2020.
