

SELF-HELP SERVICES

Provided In-Person at Courthouses of the San Diego Superior Court
By Legal Aid Society of San Diego

NOTE: The rules for ALL self-help services provided at the courthouses by LASSD are the same as for help provided by court staff to members of the public:

- The information provided to you in person by an LASSD lawyer or staff person, is not legal advice.
- The LASSD Self-Help Center lawyer is not *your* lawyer. He or she works for Legal Aid Society of San Diego and is a lawyer who can help people who do not have their own lawyer.
- You do not have an attorney-client privilege with the LASSD Self-Help Center staff or lawyer. What you say to the staff or lawyer is not confidential.
- Parties on both sides of a case can get help from the LASSD Self-Help Center, and parties on both sides of a case may be helped by the same attorney or staff person.
- Self-help services provided by LASSD are free. Anyone who does not have their own lawyer can get help from the Self-Help Center. It does not matter how much money you make.
