All SDPD Sub-Stations have gone to electronic detention logs which are printed monthly and stored in a binder for inspections and faxing to Sacramento. Definitely an update from the logbooks, and all of the Officers present were very proficient with the computer system and log in procedures for Juveniles.

Brand new facility with no Secure rooms in the building. Signage is present, but not on walls yet. Command is still designing best places and uses, etc.

66 total Non-Secure custodies under 6 Hours at the facility. Average stay was under 2 hours.

When printing out the logs from the computer, use a different colored paper for the secure custodies, regardless if there weren't any.
