

Ticket Amnesty Program

*You might be eligible for a
50% or 80% Reduction!*

To qualify for a reduction of the amount owed, all of the following conditions must be met:

- ✓ You have an unpaid ticket with an initial due date **on or before January 1, 2013.**
- ✓ The last date you made a payment was **on or before September 30, 2015.**
- ✓ You don't owe restitution to a victim on any case in the county where the violation occurred.
- ✓ You have no outstanding misdemeanor or felony warrants in the county where the violation occurred.

Not Eligible: Parking tickets or violations for driving under the influence (DUI) or reckless driving.

You may be eligible to have a driver's license hold removed:

If you are approved for amnesty and you are current on a payment plan for any infraction tickets due **after January 1, 2013.**

Program runs from October 1, 2015, through March 31, 2017
