- **Available at the County Courthouses located in downtown San Diego and East County.**
- **Tour dates are limited and scheduled on a first-come, first-serve basis.**
- **Tours are from 9:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. at the downtown courthouse and 9:30 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. at the East County courthouse.**
- **Tours are limited to a total of 35 students and adults.**
- **Schools are responsible for transportation to and from the courthouse.**
