Superior Court Internet Offers Easy-to-Use Computer Forms

The San Diego Superior Court website now offers “fillable forms” to help the public and legal community complete legal paperwork. From small claims and divorce documents to traffic infraction declarations and requests for criminal appeals, one hundred thirty-six (136) local court forms are now available in fillable format on the Court’s website

By accessing the forms, people can write in specific information and print it out via their computers. “The Court has received requests for fillable forms from our legal community for quite some time. This is a step forward in the right direction and using the new forms feature is as easy as clicking on the form link and filling them in from your desktop,” says Celeste Schwartz, Chief Information Officer for the San Diego Superior Court.

“Making it easier for the public and attorneys to complete court forms just makes sense. The litigants and attorneys will be able to prepare the forms more quickly and completely from their home or office, while court staff will find it easier and faster to review the completeness of them when being filed with the court.” adds Michael Roddy, the Superior Court’s Executive Officer.

The fillable forms feature is just one of many website services the court is developing in order to enhance court accessibility for both the public and the legal community.
