San Diego Superior Court Clarifies Temporary Restraining Orders In Light of Fire-Related Court Closure

If you were scheduled to attend a court hearing during the week of October 22, 2007 – October 26, 2007 regarding your domestic violence, elder abuse or civil harassment restraining order, your hearing date has been rescheduled.

<u>However to maintain the enforcement of your current restraining order,</u> go to the courtroom where your hearing was to be held to pick up your re-issued restraining order:
