
THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Pursuant to the provisions of section 68115 of the Government Code, it has been determined that because of the uncontrolled wildfires throughout Southern California, including the County of San Diego, there is an immediate and continuing threat to the orderly operations of the Superior Court, County of San Diego. Due to the wildfires, both President George W. Bush and Governor Schwarzenegger have declared a state of emergency for San Diego County, among others. Upon the request of Presiding Judge Kenneth K. So, it is ordered that the Superior Court, County of San Diego is authorized to do the following:

- Declare that October 24, 25, and 26, 2007, be deemed holidays for purposes of computing the time for filing papers with the court under Code of Civil Procedure sections 12 and 12a (section 68115(c));
- Declare that October 24, 25, and 26, 2007, be deemed holidays for purposes of computing time under Penal Code section 825 and Welfare and Institutions Code section 631 (section 68115(d));

This order, which supplements the order issued on October 22, 2007, is to be in effect for proceedings in which the last day of the statutory time period would occur between October 24, 2007 through and including October 26, 2007. The court must notify the Judicial Council if the circumstances necessitating this order are resolved prior to October 26, 2007.
