NOTICE TO ATTORNEYS

NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR WRIT OF EXECUTION AND WRIT OF POSSESSION OR SALE

Effective January 1, 2011, writs of execution and writs of possession or sale must specify the type of legal entity of the judgment debtor, if other than a natural person. Additionally, writs must include a statement indicating whether the case is limited civil or unlimited civil. The designation of "limited" or "unlimited" may be added in the case number field of the writ of execution or writ of possession or sale. The designation for small claims actions should be "limited." The designation for probate and family actions is "unlimited."

These requirements are a result of the passage of Assembly Bill 2394 (Ch.680), which includes amendments to Code of Civ. Proc. §§ 699.520 & 712.020.
