In light of the civil unrest in the County of San Diego, which in some instances has turned violent, the San Diego Sheriff's Department advised the San Diego Superior Court that deputies normally assigned to the court were needed for other purposes on May 31, 2020, and possibly on June 1, 2020. Given the safety concerns resulting from the civil unrest, along with the significant decrease in security for the court, the Sheriff's Department advised the court to close on June 1, 2020. Accordingly, all court locations were closed to the public on June 1, 2020.

Pursuant to the authority granted by Government Code section 68115, and the June1, 2020 Order of the Chief Justice, this Court **HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS**:

 June 1, 2020 is deemed a holiday for purposes of computing time for filing papers under Code of Civil Procedure §§ 12 and 12a.

2. June 1, 2020 is deemed a holiday for purposes of computing time under Penal Code § 825 and Welfare and Institutions Code §§ 313, 315, 334, 631, 632, 637 and 657.

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AND MAY BE AMENDED AS CIRCUMSTANCES REQUIRE.
