### FINISHING YOUR CASE

**You started your case by filing your Petition. Now what?**

There are two (2) basic steps to **finish** your case:

- Step 1: Have the other party **properly served** with the filed paperwork.
- Step 2: Obtain a **Judgment**, via agreement, default or trial.

**You don't need to wait until your Self-Represented Family Case Resolution Conference (SFRC) to finalize your case.** If you and the other party have a full agreement or if the other party does not file a Response (within 30 days of being served), the Family Law Facilitator's Office may be able to assist you.
