POST-CONVICTION RELIEF ADVISAL

If you have been convicted of a felony, you may be eligible after completion of your sentence to petition the court for dismissal of the conviction pursuant to Penal Code section 1203.41.

If you were sentenced prior to the California Public Safety Realignment Act of 2011 for a crime that otherwise would have been eligible for sentencing pursuant to Penal Code section 1170(h), you may be eligible after completion of your sentence to petition the court for dismissal of the conviction pursuant to Penal Code section 1203.42.

You may also have a right to petition for a certificate of rehabilitation and pardon.

In accordance with Penal Code section 1203.425, the Department of Justice will review convictions which occurred on or after January 1, 1973, on a monthly basis to identify those who should automatically have the record of arrest or conviction sealed within the superior court should they meet the defined qualifications.
