GUARDIANSHIP ASSISTANCE PROGRAM – GENERAL INFORMATION

This document provides general information about the court's Guardianship Assistance Program (GAP). GAP is a self-help program of the San Diego Superior Court, Family Law Facilitator's Office. The Family Law Facilitator does not represent any person or party and the assistance provided by GAP is neutral. There are no income requirements for services provided by GAP.

Services Provided by GAP:

- Informational workshops on guardianships.
- Assistance with reviewing and completing guardianship forms.
- Assistance with resolving defects in paperwork.
- Assistance with filing an objection in a San Diego guardianship case.
- Assistance with terminating a quardianship in a San Diego quardianship case.

Services NOT Provided by GAP:

- Assistance with guardianship of the estate.
- Assistance with Juvenile Court matters.
- Assistance with conservatorships.
- Assistance individuals who are currently represented by an attorney.

Options for Using GAP Services

- 1. For assistance with starting a case: Attend an informational workshop on guardianships. Workshops are held weekly and signups are available on the court website at www.sdcourt.ca.gov. From the home page, select Self-Help, then select Family Law.
- 2. For assistance with an existing case: GAP is located in the Central Courthouse at 1100 Union Street on the 5th floor, Room 571. Assistance is provided on a first-come, first-served basis. You may also call (619) 844-2869 to make an appointment for assistance.
