**GENERAL ORDER OF THE  
PRESIDING DEPARTMENT  
ORDER NO. 110520-102**

As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Governor of California declared a state of emergency in this state. The President of the United States has also declared a national emergency. The COVID-19 pandemic continues to cause significant health and safety concerns nationally, throughout the State of California, and in San Diego County.

In response to the pandemic, the court was closed to the public and suspended services, except for certain time-sensitive and essential functions, from March 17 to May 22, 2020. (See General Orders of the Presiding Department, Ord. Nos. 031820-34, 040320-39, and 043020-47.) The court resumed most services on May 26, 2020; however, with community spread of COVID-19 still a concern, many services have been and will continue to be provided remotely.

For good cause and pursuant to California Rules of Court, Appendix I: Emergency Rules Related to COVID-19, rule 3; the court's inherent supervisory and administrative authority; and the Presiding Judge's duty to promote access to justice for all members of the public, taking into account the needs of the public and court as they relate to the efficient and effective management of the court (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 10.603), and in order to protect the health and safety of the

1 public, court personnel, judicial officers, parties, attorneys, witnesses, and law enforcement  
2 officers, this court **HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

- 3 1. The Superior Court of San Diego County, Local Rules, rule 2.5.8, is suspended as to  
4 all civil cases until further notice. All parties are directed to review the COVID-19 page  
5 on the court's website ([www.sdcourt.ca.gov/coronavirus](http://www.sdcourt.ca.gov/coronavirus)) for the process by which  
6 remote appearances will be conducted for all civil cases.
- 7 2. Paragraph two (2) of the General Order of the Presiding Department of the San Diego  
8 Superior Court, In Re: Suspension of the Superior Court of San Diego County, Local  
9 Rules, rule 5.2.5; Suspension of the Superior Court of San Diego County, Local Rules,  
10 rule 2.5.8 for Small Claim Cases Only, Order No. 052620-56, is rescinded as moot. All  
11 remaining provisions of General Order No. 052620-56 shall remain in full force and  
12 effect.
- 13 3. General Order of the Presiding Department of the San Diego Superior Court, In Re:  
14 Suspension of the Superior Court of San Diego County, Local Rules, rule 2.5.8 for  
15 Unlawful Detainer Cases and Cases Seeking Civil Restraining Orders, Order No.  
16 061720-65, is rescinded as moot.
- 17 4. General Order of the Presiding Department of the San Diego Superior Court, In Re:  
18 Suspension of the Superior Court of San Diego County, Local Rules, rule 2.5.8, for (1)  
19 Limited Civil Hearings in Departments N-26 and D-61 Only; (2) Settlement  
20 Conferences and Informal Discovery Conferences in all Civil Case Types, Order No.  
21 072820-77, is rescinded as moot.
