Thus, whenever possible given available resources and in accordance with applicable law, the Court will provide language access services to LEP court users in all areas of the court, including civil, family, probate, and small claims courtroom proceedings. Any court policy or prior rule that is inconsistent with this General Order is hereby rendered void and shall have no further force or effect.
