NOTICE TO ATTORNEYS

TELEPHONIC HEARING PROCEDURE

Effective January 2, 2008, the Superior Court of California, County of San Diego, will implement a new telephonic hearing procedure that will allow attorneys to appear telephonically in civil, unlawful detainer and probate cases as provided for in the California Rules of Court ("CRC"), rule 3.670.

In accordance with the provisions of CRC 3.670(i), the court has entered into a contract with CourtCall, LLC, as the designated provider of teleconferencing services for court appearances. A party that intends to appear telephonically for a hearing listed in the rule must provide notice as specified in CRC 3.670(g). The party must also arrange the appearance with CourtCall, including following any notice requirements and payment of fees as required by CourtCall.

All telephonic appearances will be made during the court's regular calendars through the services provided by CourtCall. The court may deny a request to appear telephonically and require the parties to appear in person pursuant to CRC 3.670(h).
