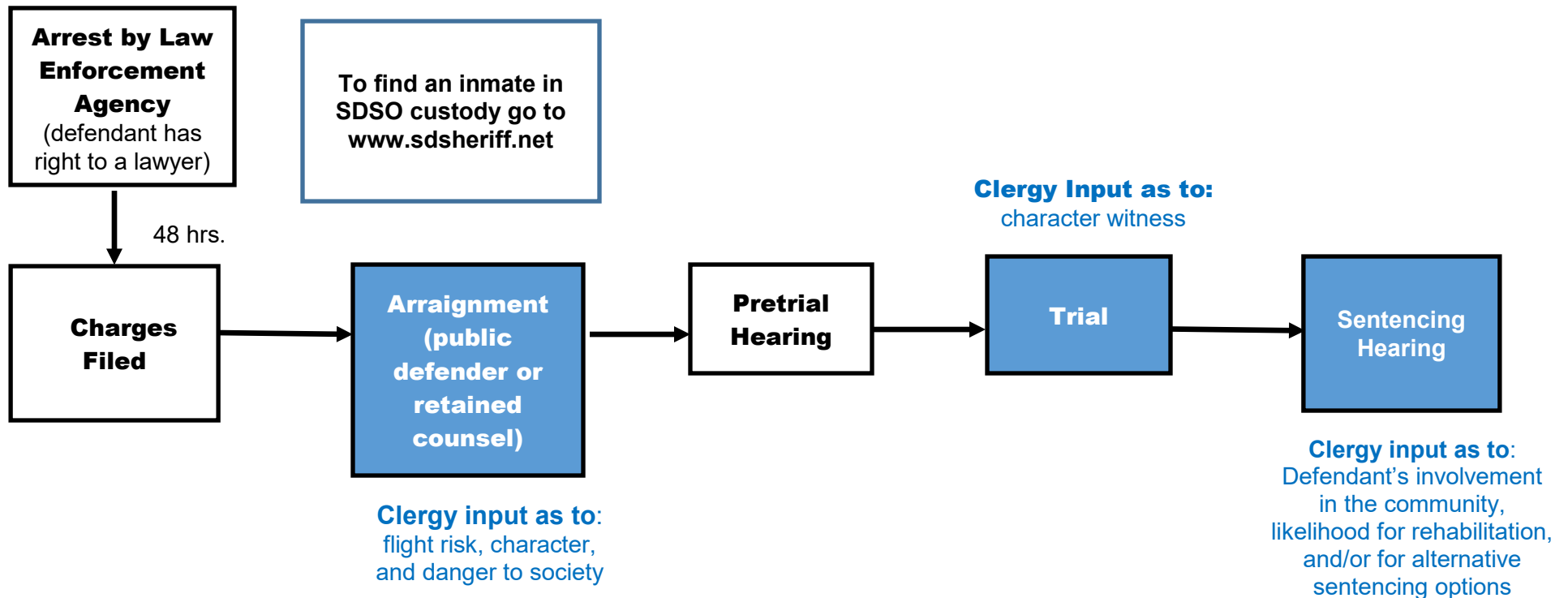

## Criminal Process (Misdemeanor)

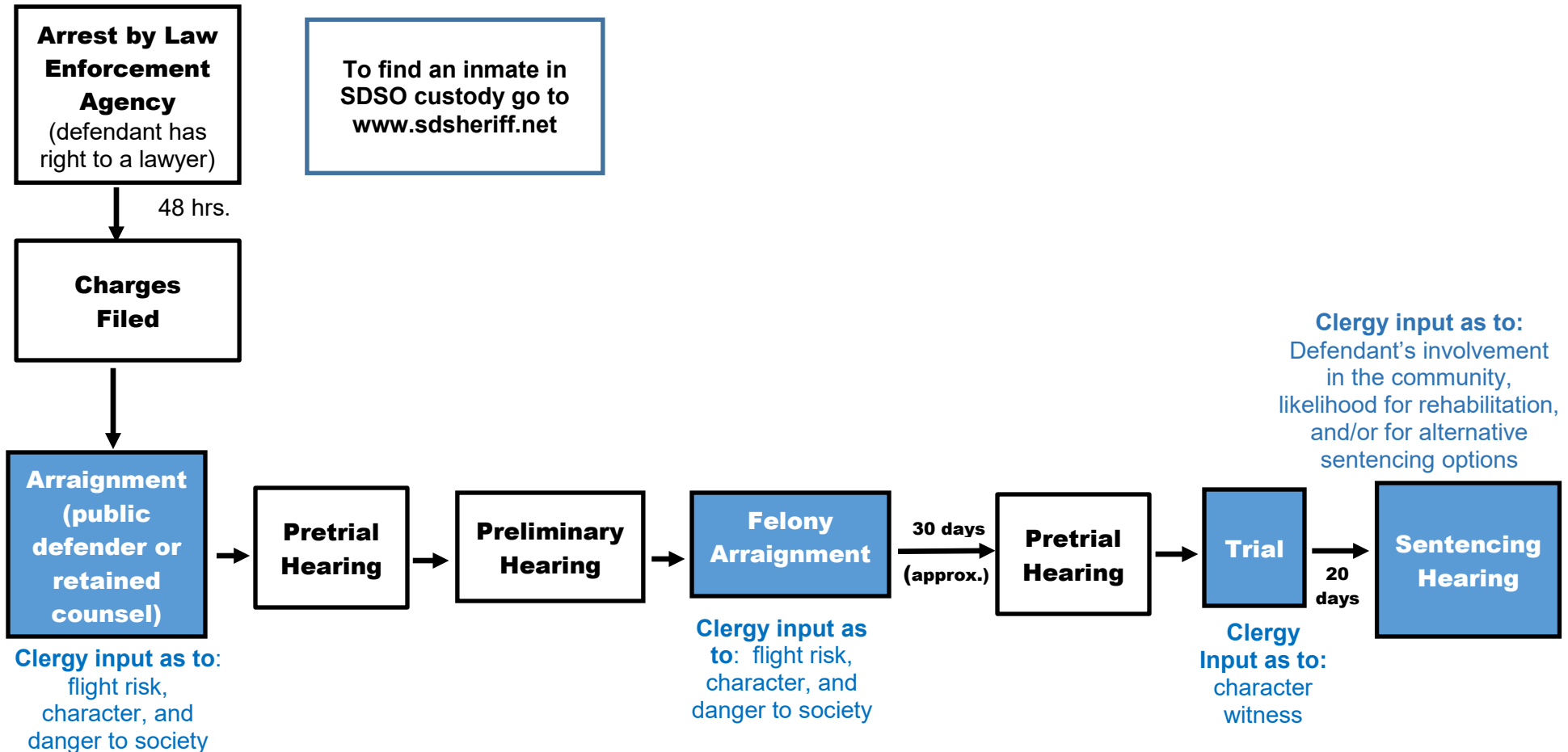
