## FORMER NORTH COUNTY EDUCATOR HEADS NEW COUNTY GRAND JURY

Valley Center resident, Victoria Stubblefield has been selected to lead the 2009-2010 San Diego County Grand Jury; the third woman selected for such an honor in the history of the Grand Jury. Stubblefield and 18 other Grand Jurors officially began service on July 7th. Stubblefield 63, retired from the Escondido Elementary School District where she spent her last four years as an 8<sup>th</sup> grade Language Arts Teacher at Rincon Middle School. During her career, she also served as an Assistant Principal at Grant Middle School (now Mission Middle School), Rose and Glen View Elementary Schools.

"I applied to be on the Grand Jury because, in retirement, I wanted to continue to serve in a greater capacity. Because the Grand Jury is the 'ultimate volunteer work,' it seemed like a perfect fit for my desire to give back to my community," says Stubblefield.

The California Constitution provides for a group of 19 citizens of the County to be brought together and dedicate a year of full-time "watchdog" service looking into the workings of government. Stubblefield adds, "Our new Grand Jury is comprised of talented people extremely eager and ready to work. Our goal will be to continue the mission of representing the citizens of San Diego County by investigating, evaluating, and reporting on the actions of local governments and special districts in a collaborative and cooperating manner. I expect that as we travel around San Diego County this next year, we shall discover great good going on in government that we can report on, as well as areas that need to improve."
