## San Diego Court-Clergy Conference Promotes Building Community Through Justice

San Diego Superior Court judges and religious leaders will meet to have a day-long dialogue about the judicial system. The goal of the program is to provide local clergy with a better understanding of the court system, court services and to enhance their ability to provide counseling to their congregations.

"Religious leaders greatly benefit from a better understanding of the family, criminal, juvenile and civil courts so that when one of their congregants is confronted with a legal issue, such as divorce, drug abuse or immigration concerns, they can provide informed advice. The knowledge gained from this conference will provide clergy with confidence when assisting parishioners who are dealing with the courts," says Superior Court Judge Laura Halgren, an organizer of the event.

The event will promote access to justice for San Diegans via avenues such as self-help programs, court website access and use of interpreters. Topics such as Family Court overview, protective orders, domestic violence, guardianships, and mandatory reporting requirements will also be discussed. The Court will provide panel discussions, informational hand-outs and Q&A
