## CHANGE IN E-FILING PROCEDURES FOR CIVIL AND PROBATE CASES EFFECTIVE APRIL 15, 2021

As of April 15, 2021, filings submitted by attorneys for represented parties in all limited and unlimited civil case types and probate actions must be submitted electronically through one of the court's approved e-filing service providers ("EFSPs"), with exceptions for certain documents. Self-represented litigants are encouraged, but not required, to e-file in these case types.

E-filers are required to comply with the San Diego Superior Court's ("SDSC") electronic filing requirements listed in the following SDSC forms: CIV-409 ("E-Filing Requirements (Civil)") and PR-188 ("E-Filing Requirements (Probate)"). These forms also contain the list of documents that are ineligible for e-filing.

In addition, please refer to the General Order of the Presiding Department: In Re Procedures Regarding Electronically Imaged Court Records, Electronic Filing, and Access to Electronic Court Records in Civil and Probate Cases (Order No. 010121-22(A), hereinafter "Order"), which mandates the change.
