On June 10, 2020, the Judicial Council of the State of California rescinded Emergency Rule 4 (the statewide Emergency Bail Schedule) previously enacted on April 6, 2020. However, the Judicial Council “urge[d] local courts to continue to use the emergency COVID-19 bail schedule where necessary to protect the health of the community, the courts, and the incarcerated.”

Pursuant to the Judicial Council’s guidance, and in collaboration with the San Diego offices of the District Attorney, City Attorney, Public Defender, and Sheriff, this court hereby adopts for use the San Diego Superior Court Temporary Emergency Modification to the Bail Schedule (“TEMBS”), effective June 29, 2020, as amended effective November 5, 2021. The TEMBS modifies the current annual San Diego Superior Court Bail Schedule.

Requests for a modification of a bail amount, or for conditions of release, shall be made to the daytime or after-hours duty judge. If bail is modified, or conditions imposed, the court will notify the Sheriff's Watch Commander at the detention facility where the defendant is housed, and the Sheriff shall note the change on defendant's paperwork, including any release papers.

Based on the above, General Order 010121-42 is hereby rescinded.
